Computer Education

Computer technology is integrated into the instructional program by classroom teachers as directed by the Virginia Standards of Learning for computer/technology. This integration is accomplished by using available computers, tablets, or BYOD within the classroom or scheduling activities in the computer resource lab and library media center.

Students receive instruction in the operation of a computer, basic keyboard awareness, basic word processing, database and spread-sheet operation, and interaction with computer-assisted instructional software. Students may also have the opportunity to use programs for generating and using computer graphics, multimedia, and the Internet.
